



## 2023 AIA Central Valley Regional Recognition Entry

Regional Recognition nominations acknowledge built projects that represent a regional character, iconic presence, and timeless expression of architectural quality.

Projects may be from any past or present time period and can be original construction, reconstruction, or restoration. Projects are not required to be designed by AIACV members or firms, but must be located within the Chapter membership area (counties of Sacramento, Amador, Yolo, El Dorado, Placer, Nevada, Colusa, Sutter, Yuba, Sierra, Butte, Plumas, Glenn, Tehama, Shasta, Alpine or Lassen). Projects not designed for, or completed within, the Chapter area will not be considered.

AIACV members, in good standing, may nominate a project for consideration. Members may submit up to three (3) different entries, but may not nominate their own projects. Each submittal must have a separate entry form and separate image. There is no fee to enter.
